

according to the table below:

Virtual entries

- supplier orders: date of receipt
- supplier invoices: payment date
- receipt vouchers: date of receipt

Virtual outings

- customer quote: date of acceptance
- customer order: validation date
- customer invoices: collection date
- BL: delivery date

The **Potential stock at DD/MM** column displays the virtual stock calculated to date, which gives greater precision for the overall virtual stock, expressed without notion of date. It is displayed according to the settings of [replenishment options](#).

The **ST** (status) column displays the stock status of the product, based on the defined stock thresholds (alert, safety, maximum stocks).

The 1 drop-down list allows you to select other views:

- the **Valuation** view presents the valuation of the stock for sale (in PU Sale and PAMP)
- the **Stock+Valo** view presents the elements of the two previous views
- the **Order** view presents the number of products to order immediately, based on current stocks and stock alerts

The **Enter** and **Exit** buttons allow you to enter stock entries and exits for the product selected in the table.

The **Availability/Empl** button displays availability by location, if the locations are managed.

The **Replenishment** button initiates a supplier order for the products selected in the table, which require replenishment, based on your stock management objectives, while the **Dde prx** button generates a price request based on the same rules.

The 2 button limits the display to products with non-zero current stock.

Stock valuation view

The Valuation view has the following columns:

- **Valuation** presents the valuation of the stock on sale, the stock being valued by the formula: PU excluding VAT sale * Qty in stock
- **PAMP Valuation** presents the valuation of the stock according to the weighted average purchase price (PAMP), the stock being valued by the formula: PU excluding VAT sale * PAMP

Note: The PAMP is calculated using one of the methods specified in the [general application](#)

[configuration](#) (CUMP, PEPS/FIFO, or DEPS/LIFO).

Before using the PAMP valuation column, it is necessary to ensure that the last PAMP calculation was carried out on the reference date that suits you, as described on the page [Calculation of PAMP](#). For example, if you want the day-to-day valuation, recalculate the PAMP on today's date then consult this screen, or if you want it on the closing date of your financial year, recalculate the PAMP on this date then consult this screen (the screen does not recalculate the PAMP, which must be calculated first).

Context menu options



- **Stock movement:** opens the list of stock movements for the selected product, either the general screen or the detail screen including virtual stocks.
- **Transfer between locations:** allows you to transfer a quantity of the selected product to another (if the locations are managed)
- **Filter by quantity in stock:** allows you to display only products whose stock is below a threshold
- **Select this supplier:** allows you to select all products from the same supplier, for a supplier order or a price request
- **Restock** and **Price Request** allow you to perform the same actions as the **Restock** and **Price Request** buttons, but with additional restock options

The screen options menu offers: * **Do not display products without alert** allows you not to display products “without stock alert”, i.e. whose alert stock and minimum stock are at zero.

- **Show archived products:** allows you not to display archived products.
